Grace Group Questions for this Sunday's Sermon:

1. What did God stir in your heart as a result of our time in Isaiah 2:22 – 4:6? Discuss what the Holy Spirit is doing in you?
2. Why can discussion about “pride” be so deceptive? How do we overcome this deception so that we can see ourselves honestly and repent?
3. Is it difficult to answer the question, “In Whom/What Do I Trust”? Why? In answering this, remember how easy it is for us as a nation to have “In God We Trust” on our money, yet live as if he does not even exist. In other words, we have the capacity to believe something theologically, yet deny its reality in our everyday living. Who/What does our everyday life point to as our object of trust? Who/What do we truly trust? Pray that God would expose our hearts so that we can see clearly.
4. Israel has to suffer loss for their misplaced trust to be exposed. How is that merciful? What losses might you or Christians in general have to suffer so that we will prize only Christ as our true gain?
5. How would our lives be different if we cherished Christ above our jobs, money, possessions, relationships, future, etc.? Pray for one another for the honesty to see what we set up as idols and what we need to repent of.
6. Once again we see into the future and the glorious work of God to restore order to his creation and to his people. Reflect on our own future, discussed last week in Revelation 21-22. Thank God for his glorious work. Pray for one another that even now he alone will be exalted in our lives.
