Grace Group Questions for this Sunday's Sermon:

1. What is the Lord impressing on your heart from the study in Isaiah 6? Was there a focus to your prayer during the ministry time?

TANGENT: Take a few moments and discuss how you are using the “ministry time” at the end of our services. Help one another maximize this time by giving them ideas or sharing stories of how God is working through this time.

2. Just what does it mean to “see” idols? What are the ways we naturally do this in our lives? What does it mean to “become like” them? Pray for one another that this kind of “seeing” would be crushed in your lives.
3. What does it mean to “see” the Lord? How can we cultivate this in our lives? What would it look like to “become like” him? Share with one another the ways God is helping you to do this.
4. Once again, we get “hope”...just a little, but we get it. Let “hope” settle in on your soul. In light of the passage, what does “hope” mean for you right now? The context points to a necessary judgment because the people have forsaken the Lord with the hope being the fact that the Lord is still going to do a work in his people. Additionally, beyond the passage, what does “hope” mean for you presently? Do you need others to pray for you that you would have “hope”?
