### Grace Group Questions for this Sunday's Sermon:

- 1) What did God stir in your heart during this particular passage? How did this passage impact you?
- 2) What does it “look like” to live with an awareness of the presence of God? Should this truth have an impact on the way we move through victory and difficulty?
- 3) Do you truly fear the Lord? OR is your fear more in your circumstances, the direction of culture, a particular person? How does one repent and live in fear of the Lord above anything or anyone else?
- 4) The remnant (8:17) follow God’s word with patient trust. What other “voices” are calling to those in the church today? How do we “harden” ourselves to these “voices” and remain sensitive to the word of God?
- 5) Do you have hope in a coming day, when the Lord reclaims his kingdom, that which is rightfully his? Do you long for this? The struggled with this truth in Peter’s day (cf. 2 Pet 3) How can such a hope change our perspective on present circumstances? Are proclaiming this “hope” to others who need the Lord? To other believers who need encouragement? Pray that the Lord would gives us rock solid assurance as we await the day.
