

Grace Group Questions for February 28, 2010

1. Isaiah 9:1-7 was all about the glorious hope that the Messiah would in fact come and bring in God's kingdom. Talk a little bit about the 'hopes' that often drive us and how important it really is to have this glorious hope motivating our lives.
2. This might have been the first time many of you have heard Isaiah 9:1-7 preached when it wasn't Christmas. Do you feel that you could 'hear' the passage differently because it's not Christmas time?
3. Do you tend to forget the acts of the Lord on your behalf? Spend some time and remember together and share an event or something significant that the Lord has done in your life. Encourage one another with these memories!
4. Of the great names (Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace) given to the Lord Jesus which do you need most in your life right now and why?
5. The Zeal of the Lord will make these things happen – God pursues His people to bring about change for their good. Think about and share other passages of scripture where God is pursuing His people for their good. Encourage one another with a time of sharing passages of scripture that remind us that God is always proactive towards us in redemption.
